Map of John F. Kennedy Airport, New York

This map is provided for your convenience. Most travelers to Egypt will find that they will connect through Kennedy Airport in New York on their way to and from Cairo.

This map is believed to be accurate as of the time it was initially prepared but **Museum Tours assumes no liability for its accuracy or use.**

IMPORTANT: When you receive your tickets, make sure you call your **domestic and international airline to reconfirm your flight** and time of departure from your hometown to New York and Cairo.

If you have your international ticket with you when you check in, you should be able to **check your bags all the way through to Cairo** from your city of departure. Maximum weight allowed per bag is 50 lbs.

If you are flying on Egypt Air, when you arrive at Kennedy take the interline shuttle (a free service that runs about every 10 minutes) to the **West Entrance of the International Building (Terminal 4).**

Egypt Air check-in is on the top floor, Row 7.

There are bus (about every half hour), limousine (about every hour) and helicopter (about every 40 minutes) shuttles between Kennedy/LaGuardia and Kennedy/Newark airports. Check at the airport for schedules and costs.
